Parking on Mt. Carmel Avenue is restricted in many locations. **READ THE SIGNS! Hamden police **DO** tag illegal parking, especially on hike day.**

Some Packs or dens chose to hike either before or after the day of the event. If you contact the event chairman before your hike, and if the Cubs hike, they can earn the patch.

Units are reminded of the required adult coverage. First Aid kits are required on the hike and at the unit cookout sites.

On the scheduled day of the hike, tour permits are not required. On other hike dates, they are required. Make sure appropriate attire is worn by all.
