

## **Registration for Cub Scout/Webelos Resident Camp 2012**

Registration for the Cub Scout/Webelos Resident Camp programs at Deer Lake is now open.

There are five sessions for Cub Scouts/Webelos (boys going into 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade in September 2012):

- Session 1: Thursday, July 26 – Sunday, July 29
- Session 2: Monday, July 30 – Wednesday, August 1
- Session 3: Thursday, August 2 – Sunday, August 5
- Session 5: Thursday, August 9 – Sunday, August 12
- Session 6: Monday, August 13 – Wednesday, August 15

There are two sessions for Webelos only (boys going into 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade in September 2012):

- Session 4: Monday, Aug. 6 – Wednesday, Aug. 8
- Session 7: Thursday, August 16 – Sunday, August 19

Each session will accommodate 200 campers (youth and adults combined). Spots will be filled first come, first served. Registrations may be submitted by individual families or by units. Registration forms accompanied by payment, either the full fee or a minimum non-refundable deposit of \$50 per youth/adult partnership, will secure spots in the requested session until all available spots are filled.

Registrations paid in full by May 1, 2012 are eligible for the Early Bird rate. If a \$50 deposit is paid, the balance must be paid in full by May 1 to be eligible for the Early Bird rate. Payment of the deposit alone by May 1 does not entitle the registrant to the Early Bird discount. Fees not paid in full by May 1 will be charged at the regular rate and must be paid in full by July 1, 2012. Registrations not paid in full by July 1 will be opened up to families on the waiting list or new registrants on a first come, first served basis. The 2012 camp fees are posted on the website.

### **FAQs**

#### **If a Pack wants to secure spots for a certain number of youth/adult pairs, what do they need to do?**

The pack may collect individual registration forms with payments and submit them to the Milford Scout office. Alternatively, the unit coordinator may fill out a unit registration form, listing individual names or indicating the desired number of spots and submit the form with a minimum of \$50 per partnership. (For example: A unit registration form indicating "10 families" would be accompanied by a minimum payment of \$500.)

#### **If Pack families register individually, will they be placed together in the same campsite?**

Every effort will be made to group registrations received prior to campsite assignment (usually early July) together by pack. Once site assignments have been announced, it may not be possible to place new registrants in the same site as other members of their pack.

**What is the refund policy?**

Each registration requires a \$50 non-refundable deposit per session. 100% of the remainder is refundable if requested before June 30, 2012. Camp fee minus \$150 will be returned if withdrawal is made on or after July 1, 2012. Refund requests must be made in writing and submitted to the Milford Scout office.
