Refund Policy: Each session requires a \$50 non-refundable deposit. Refunds for the balance of the fees are made only for the following reasons:

1) Serious illness, accident or death in the immediate family, 2) Camper is required to attend summer school which conflicts with the day camp schedule, 3) Family moves outside of Council boundaries prior to the start of camp. All refund requests must be made in writing and submitted to the Council office. Requests will be considered on a case by case basis.
