





CAMPING: September 27, 2019, starting at 4:00 PM RACING: September 28, 2019, 9:00 AM – 6:00 PM

The Yellow Tickets are for Adults and Boy Scouts. The Blue Tickets are for Cub Scouts and Siblings.

Scout Day at Lime Rock promises to be a fun and exciting event. During your stay, please observe the following rules:

Please distribute group tickets ahead of time or be sure the first person to arrive at the site has tickets to hand out to everyone else in your group. If you are meeting your group to distribute tickets on site, you will need to wait for your families at the entrance, not in the camping area. *Everyone must have their tickets to enter the gate*.

Campers may begin arriving after 4:00 PM Friday evening, September 27. Please note that, due to another program occurring Friday, Scout Day participants will not be allowed to enter before 4 PM. Enter through the Main (Infield) entrance, present your tickets and sign in at the Guest Services building.

Stop at the Scout registration pavilion (look for the flashing yellow light) to check in. A committee member will advise you on where to camp. Please arrange a means for getting your group together in advance. It gets dark early and can be difficult to locate your group in the camping area after nightfall. Use of cell phones is recommended although cell service can be weak in the park. Cars should be parked in the parking lot after equipment is off-loaded.

If arriving Friday evening, you may eat before arrival, bring your dinner with you, or check the Council website for a list of area restaurants provided by Lime Rock Park.

Ground fires are not permitted. Food concessions are available to purchase meals on Saturday.

If you want to leave and come back you must pick up a re-entry bracelet at the SCOUT CHECK IN PAVILION (look for the flashing yellow light) before departing. Please be sure to show your bracelet to the gate guard upon re-entering the park.

The Friday night cracker-barrel will begin at 9:00 PM and is open to adults only. You may pick up your unit's patches at this time. Please remember to leave two-deep leadership in your campsite.

Campers must remain in the campground until 7:30 a.m. Saturday morning. This means no one is allowed in the paddock areas or any of the buildings on the property. Failure to observe this rule could result in your dismissal from the park.

For your safety, take a "buddy" along whenever you leave your tenting area.

Please adhere to the BSA policy on alcohol consumption: "The Boy Scouts of America prohibits the use of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances at encampments or activities on property owned and/or operated by the Boy Scouts of America, or at any activity involving the participation of youth members." <u>GUIDE TO SAFE SCOUTING.</u>

An adult leader or parent must accompany anyone under the age of 18 wishing to enter the paddock (pit) area. (Groups of Scouts may enter as long as there are two or more leaders present.) Please visit the paddock area after the races begin, not before. No one is allowed to touch or climb in/on cars unless the driver/owner is present and gives express permission.

Scouts occasionally have the opportunity to take home tires and auto part souvenirs given by the car owner. Be careful not to take something which was not gifted. If you have second thoughts, any tire not taken home may be left at the SCOUT CHECK IN PAVILION. Please pile them neatly.

If you are arriving on Saturday morning, please park as instructed by the park security personnel and proceed to the infield spectator area. You must have your tickets in your possession. Connecticut Yankee Council Scout Day at Lime Rock tickets are not available at the gate. Gates open at 7:30 AM Saturday morning. The last race ends at 6:00 PM. You should plan to be off property by 7:00 PM.

Frequently asked questions:

<u>What should I bring?</u> Lime Rock is a unique motor sport venue in that all spectating is done from a grassy landscaped viewing area shaded by trees. For most comfort, blankets and lawn chairs are a must. You may also want to bring along insect repellant, suntan lotion and rain gear, just in case. You may bring a cooler but no glass containers are permitted.

<u>May we bring/ride bikes?</u> Yes, but <u>youth and adults must wear a helmet</u> at all times while riding and bike riding is restricted to the camping area only. Youth may wish to participate in the Bike Rodeo, Saturday, 10 am – 2 pm.

<u>Can I purchase food there?</u> Absolutely, the Paddock A concession stand will be open on Saturday from 7:30 am to approximately 4 pm.

<u>May I BBQ?</u> Yes, but only in the camping area and cooking must be done on a camp stove or bring your grill or hibachi. No ground fires please.

<u>Can I bring my dog?</u> No. Dogs are not allowed on the Lime Rock Park property during track events.

What if it rains? All road-racing events run rain or shine.

<u>What about those Hot Laps?</u> Hot Laps will be awarded at the crackerbarrel along with information on when and where to assemble. Hot Lap participants must be 21 years or older.

How do I get there?

From New Haven: Take Rt. 34W to Rt. 8N to Torrington. Take Rt. 4W to Cornwall Bridge. Take Rt. 7N to Rt. 112 W. Go past Outfield Entrance for 6/10ths of a mile to the Main Entrance on left, located on White Hollow Road.

From Danbury: Take 84E to exit 7 (US-7N/US-202 Brookfield/New Milford). Continue on 7N for 30 mi. to Rt. 112 W. Go past Outfield Entrance for 6/10ths of a mile to the Main Entrance on left, located on White Hollow Road.

From the West: Take Rt. 84E to Route 22 North to Millerton. Take Rt. 44 East to Route 112 East. Main Entrance is on right, located on White Hollow Road.

The Main Gate entrance is at 60 White Hollow Rd, Lakeville, CT 06039. Directions are available on the Lime Rock website.
