Important Information:

Required Paperwork: All campers, youth and adult, must submit a camp health form and Authorization for the Administration by School, Child Care, and Youth Camp Personnel http://www.ct.gov/oec/lib/oec/licensing/childcare/cdc_yc_adminmeds.pdf and the Medical Administration Record. In addition, all youth campers must have all documents contained in the confirmation packet completed and returned prior to the start of camp. Health forms and confirmation packets can be downloaded from the Council website: <http://www.ctyankee.org/camping>
If your Scout attends more than one week of camp, you need to provide copies of all documents for each camp. Council will not be responsible for transferring forms from one session to another. Please keep your original health forms and submit a copy or copies to us.

Refund Policy: Each session requires a \$50 non-refundable deposit. Refunds for the balance of the fees are made only for the following reasons: 1) Serious illness, accident or death in the immediate family, 2) Camper is required to attend summer school which conflicts with the day camp schedule, 3) Family moves outside of Council boundaries prior to the start of camp. All refund requests must be made in writing and submitted to the Council office. Requests will be considered on a case by case basis.
