



Camp Sequassen Key Position Recognition

Purpose: The intent of this policy is to set some practical limits and guidelines with regard to the long-standing convention, to give recognition to those holding key positions important to the welfare and success of Camp Sequassen.

Background: Pryor to this policy the convention was as follows: to paint the Position held, the individuals name and the year they took the position, on two approximate 8” wide by 10” high wooden arrow head mockups which were painted bright yellow. Both of these were then mounted on the camps (at the time) main gateway. When that individual no longer held that position theirs were taken down, that year was painted in and one arrowhead was displayed in the Dining Hall’s dining room and the other was presented to the individual. This worked fine for many decades, but with time change comes, in this case two main changes; a new main gateway and the repainting and decoration of the dining room. Also the number of accumulated arrow heads is becoming unmanageable.

Updated Policy: Following the previous convention, a single arrow head is to be created and displayed in a prominent location, such as the camps information kiosk. In addition, framed, common, historical listings will be maintained and displayed in an appropriate location such as the Dining Hall, Camp Office or Welcome Area. This listing will include the position held the individual’s full name as well as the period they held the position (month and year, from – till) listed by start date. When that individual no longer holds that position their arrow head is to be taken down (that year will then be added) and presented to the individual, and the historical listing updated. The listing is to be done in a consistent style that adds to the character of our camp.

- Camp Program Director (for Boy Scout Resident Camp)
- Camp Ranger
- Camp Director (for Boy Scout Resident Camp)
- Camp Maintenance Chairman
- Council Camping Committee Chairman
- Council President
- Council Program Director
- Council Scout Executive
- Other (prior to 2007) distinctions

Authority: The Council Camping Committee has final authority in all matters relative to this policy, with due consideration to advice from the Camp Ranger, the Camp Director and the Director of Program.
