Scout Day at Lime Rock

September 27 – 28, 2019

Start your program year with a Fall outing at Lime Rock Park! An easy campout Friday night followed by an all-day Saturday program of racing make this event an all-time favorite. Take advantage of a foot-long hot dog and tater fries lunch from the track's food concession or you can prepare your own meals track-side. Either way, your Scouts will be hooked on Scouting forever. Saturday's races will provide hours of racing excitement, featuring Vintage Sports Car Club of America's Fall Finale as well as the exotic sports cars of the Lime Rock Driver's Club. Come see vintage and collectible sports cars of all types spanning many years of automotive history – all in tip top condition and in action on the track.

COST: Scouts/Adults = \$15 Cubs & siblings under 10 = \$7

Fee includes an event patch for the first 1000 registrants, Friday night camping and adult leader social (cracker barrel) and Hot Laps for 20 lucky Scouters. What's a Hot Lap? It's two high speed laps around the LRP race track in a race car driven by a skilled and licensed race car driver. The ride will be fast enough to be an exhilarating experience! To qualify for a Hot Lap, you must be 21+ and a registered Scout leader. Hot Laps will be run during intermissions. Five Hot Lap passes will be awarded to the units with the most registered Scouts in attendance, the remainder will be door prizes at the crackerbarrel.

Scouting in the 21st Century A Return to Basic

October 19-20, 2019 – Hoyt Scout Reservation

Join us for a weekend of family fun with a “A Return to Basic” Scouting Skills theme. All of the activities, knot tying, use of compass, hikes, fire safety, leave no trace and more to be mapped to Required Cub Scout Adventures. Come for the day or enjoy one night of camping.

Eight Action Stations:

1. **Vertical Run Inflatable Obstacle Course:** Squeeze through tunnels, jump over barriers, slip underneath bars, and push your way past any obstacle that comes your way while trying to move as fast as possible with this new course!
2. **BB Shoot:** Cub Scouts will learn the safe and responsible use of BB guns, and to have fun in a safe range conducted by qualified adults.
3. **Compass/How to Use a Compass:** Explain the parts of the Compass. How to find North. What that means, and how to navigate with one around a simple course.
4. **Knots/Knot Tying/The Six Scout Knots:** Have fun learning the basic Scout Knots.
5. **Leave No Trace for Every Kid/Leaf What You Find (Leaf Tracing):** Discovering the fun of spending time outdoors and learning about responsibility for the environment.
6. **Campfire How To & Safety/Smokey the Bear for Kids:** Having a campfire fire is a big responsibility. Scouts will learn fire-making process and about campfire safety. We are working on a special appearance by Smokey the Bear.
7. **Flag Folding/Flag Ceremony:** Scouts will learn Flag etiquette and ceremonies.
8. **Cub Scout Games:** Special Guest will lead Cub Scouts through a series of repeat after me songs and fun Cub Scout games.

- ➔ Programs start Saturday morning with a 10:30 AM hike and Opening at 11:30 AM.

- ➔ Discounted Early Bird Fee -- \$15.00 Youth & \$10.00 Adult Fee if paid in full by October 4, 2019. Note we discounted the adult early bird fee from \$12 (last year) to \$10.00 (new).
- ➔ Fee includes: Patch, program and camp fees.
- ➔ **Extra Lunch at the canteen—\$6/person.** Hot dog, fries and drinks. Proceeds benefit Hoyt.



The 2020 District Pinewood Derby Championship

Saturday, March 28, 2020
Please give this your attention

1. District Pinewood Derby Race will take place **Saturday, March 28, 2020**. This is an earlier date to avoid conflicts with spring sports.
2. Cub Packs are asked to hold their Pinewood Derby prior to this date.
3. We are asking all Packs to adopt the District Pinewood Derby Guidelines in running your Pack Race. This will standardize all packs on the same guidelines and allow for easy entry in the District Championship.
4. Each Pack can send the following winners to the District Championship:
 - Lions top winners up to 3
 - Tigers top winners up to 3
 - Wolf top winners up to 3
 - Bear top winners up to 3
 - Webelos top winners up to 3
 - AOL Webelos winners up to 3
 - Each pack can enter up to 18 entries.
5. The District Pinewood Derby Championship will take place at Stepping Stones Museum for Children, Matthew Park, 303 West Ave., Norwalk with family fun programs and discounted prices.

Top Winner in each division can advance to race in the **New York City World Championship Pinewood Derby Race**.
2020 Date to be announced but usually the last weekend in June held in Times Square.

Basic Guidelines (turn over for complete guidelines)

- To race in the District Pinewood Derby Championship Race entries must be approved by the Pack Leadership.
- The same car raced at the Pack Pinewood Derby must be used at the District Championship Race. No substitutes permitted.
- The current "BSA Grand Prix Pinewood Derby Kit" is the official kit for the District Championships.
- Only the axles, wheels, and wood provided in this kit are permitted.
- Maximum width, including wheels, of completed car is 2-3/4 inches.
- Axle grooves cannot be relocated or altered in any way. Axles may be glued into place, however axle grooves cannot be filled or covered and the ends of the nails (points) must be visible.
- Maximum overall length of completed car - 7 inches.
- No part of the car may protrude beyond the track start gate starting pin. The front edge of the car must not be more than 1 inch above the track surface and be at least 1/2 inch wide at the center of the car.
- Cars must clear the center rail of the track, which is 1 5/8 inches wide by 1/4 inch tall along the entire length of the car. Minimum clearance between the entire bottom of the car and the bottom of the

wheels shall be 3/8 of an inch.

- Maximum weight - 5 ounces.

Examples of Prohibited Items which CANNOT be used:

- Any type of magnets, springs, washers, bearings, bushings, nylon shims, axle guards, wheel weights, wheel well weights, inner wheel air dams, inner or outer wheel covers – clear or otherwise, or any item internal or external to a factory BSA wheel, moving weights, liquid lubricants actively wet or dried, or suspension systems of any type.
- Any item not included in an official BSA Pinewood Derby Car Kit or not purchased through an authorized BSA retailer, except cosmetic items or fenders.
- Starting devices, finish line devices, propellants, or propulsion systems.
- Wet paint, sticky substances, glass, excessively fragile parts, electronic or lighting devices (lights on the car are not permitted).
- Bearings or solid one-piece rod style axles or after-market purchased axles.
- Axles and wheels attached to any device that mechanically alters rotation or spin.
- Loose objects on or in the car. All weight must be securely fastened or embedded in or on the car.

Please make payments online and pay BEFORE the event or by the established deadline. We prefer that Packs, Troops, and Crews complete registration and payment as a unit. Consider a unit debit card to make the payment, to avoid having unit volunteers to use personal credit or debit cards. We can also debit activity payments from your unit account provided there are funds in the account.

Refund Policy & Sport Conflicts

There will be no refunds given unless there are extreme circumstances. Please understand that when you register a youth for our program supplies and materials are purchased for them and as such we will not be able to refund money for any other reason. Sport conflicts are not considered an extreme circumstance.

Sports Conflicts: Scouts can register for District Activities and can be permitted to come and go for sports or other conflicts. There are no make-up session provided for programs missed and fee remains the same. Units are responsible for signing in and out Scouts at the district event. Guide to Safe Scouting guidelines must be used.

Training

All registered adult leaders must complete Position Specific Training required by BSA for their registered position. **You only have to take this training once.**


