
# **Scout Day at Lime Rock** September 27 – 28, 2019


Start your program year with a Fall outing at Lime Rock Park! An easy campout Friday night followed by an all-day Saturday program of racing make this event an all-time favorite. Take advantage of a foot-long hot dog and tater fries lunch from the track's food concession or you can prepare your own meals track-side. Either way, your Scouts will be hooked on Scouting forever. Saturday's races will provide hours of racing excitement, featuring Vintage Sports Car Club of America's Fall Finale as well as the exotic sports cars of the Lime Rock Driver's Club. Come see vintage and collectible sports cars of all types spanning many years of automotive history – all in tip top condition and in action on the track.

#### COST: Scouts/Adults = \$15

#### Cubs & siblings under 10 = \$7

Fee includes an event patch for the first 1000 registrants, Friday night camping and adult leader social (cracker barrel) and Hot Laps for 20 lucky Scouters. What's a Hot Lap? It's two high speed laps around the LRP race track in a race car driven by a skilled and licensed race car driver. The ride will be fast enough to be an exhilarating experience! To qualify for a Hot Lap, you must be 21+ and a registered Scout leader. Hot Laps will be run during intermissions. Five Hot Lap passes will be awarded to the units with the most registered Scouts in attendance, the remainder will be door prizes at the crackerbarrel.





See how your patrol stacks up against the other patrols in the District in solving the mystery. Opening ceremony will begin with a crime scene which will set the stage for solving a crime scene mystery. The CSI Camporee will be organized into a number of activities where Scouts will learn how to gather and analyze evidence which they then can use to solve the mystery. Here's what we are working on!

- Station 1 Searching the Crime Scene and Evidence Collection: Learn how to gather and preserve evidence from a crime scene. How would you locate, and catalogue evidence found over a wide area? Each patrol will need a digital camera to take photos.
- Station 2 Detective Work and Visiting the Morgue: Learn some of the tools of a detective including timelines, reconstruction, organizing evidence, and chain of custody.
- Station 3 − Eyewitness Evidence: Try your hand at interviewing witnesses and suspects. How good are eyewitness observations? Do eyewitnesses make many mistakes?
- Station 4 Fingerprints: Learn how to find and preserve fingerprints from a crime scene.
- Station 5 − DNA Lab: This lab helps them determine whose blood was left at the crime scene and what type of weapon may have been used based on the pattern of the blood splatter.
- Station 6 Trace Evidence Lab: This lab will be used to identify evidence found on the victim.
- Station 7 Impressions Lab: This lab will help to identify the footprints left behind at the crime scene.

- ✿ Station 8 Ballistics: Learn to identify cartridge casings and bullets from their markings and determine from which vantage point and direction did a series of shots come from.
- Station 9 Photography: Learn to take crime scene photographs. Each patrol will need a digital camera.
- Station 10 − Forensic Science Lab: Use of highpowered microscopes Scouts will exam slides to learn and study evidence just like professionals do.
- Station 11 Meet the Judge: Scouts will learn about the judicial procedures in CSI with obtaining search warrants, subpoenas, and preparing evidence for a prosecutor to take to court.
- Station 12 The Wrecking Ball Inflatable: Just for fun! Four Players climb atop their inflated pads. One of the players grabs the "Wrecking Ball" and hurls it at their opponent in an attempt to knock the player off of their inflated pad.
- Closing Station Making the Arrest! Patrols will have 10 minutes to gather all of the forms they have completed from the stations to turn in and to complete the "Solving the Crime" sheet. The Suspect will be revealed and arrested!

- Ultimate Frisbee Tournament Trophies and Disc give-a-ways. Eight Teams limit.
- Scoutmasters (Adults) Vs Youth fun activities after the stations close.
- Earn Fingerprinting Merit Badge and spark an interest sessions with Crime Prevention and Photography Merit Badge.

### Dear Scout Leaders,

Once again we would like to invite a team of older Scouts from our troops and crews to teach at the Webelos Adventure College with at least one adult advisor. This has been a very successful and overbooked event for the last several years. We're not looking for your entire Troop or Crew, but just 3 to 5 youth and at least one adult.

**A great concept....** "While Webelos Scouts pass requirements at the Webelos College and get to know Scouts BSA as teachers and role models, the Scouts gain experience planning, teaching classes, and dealing with younger youth who can sometimes present a challenge."

This provides another opportunity for Webelos to get comfortable working with Scouts and to get them excited about joining a troop. Troops that participate are welcome to set up an information table on their troop and talk to parents (in the parents lounge).

Scouts would NOT sign off in Webelos Books and/or requirements but we would leave it to the Webelos Den Leader to feel confident that the requirements were taught properly. Each troop would bring an adult advisor to work with the Scouts and to set up the class. Class sizes were large last year so we suggest that teams use rotation stations to teach the badge. Make the class fun.

It may not be possible to pass all of the requirements at the Webelos College. We will develop a list of prerequisites to give out ahead of time.
