




### Cathy Giorgio Troop 35






### Hector Asuncion Pack 97




### Sonia Asuncion Pack 97

## Sean McDuffee Pack 97


Sean is a Tiger Den Leader. Pack 97 thanks him for creating exciting and safe Den meetings.






## Joel DeGray Troop 5




## Alan Gerard Troop 5

Eric has been the Committee Chair for two years and has done a great job rallying the parents to support the Troop.






## Aileen Masone Troop 125
