

You may use (but not required):

- ◆ Covid-19 or Coronavirus reference.
- ◆ Powahay's 40th Anniversary 1980 to 2020. (Or 1980 vs 2020)
- ◆ Powahay Powahay was a native Chief that lived in our area. Respectful Native American interpretation permitted.
- ◆ The logo for Powahay District is a medicine feather from a Shaman, or Indian medicine man. Our logo is... "The feather is strong medicine for curing and for strength of mind, body and character."

Use your imagination. Make your artwork colorful and - most importantly – have FUN!

- ♦ Only vertical 8 ½ x 11 paper permitted. No other size will be considered.
- Must be Scouting related.
- Use markers or paints. Bright colors enhance your artwork.
- No computer images, hand drawings only.
- You must create your own artwork (without help from parents/siblings). Parents, however, are encouraged to check your entry for errors before submitting to avoid disqualification.
- ◆ Include the words "POWAHAY DISTRICT", "TIME CAPSULE" and "2020" in your artwork.
- Only ONE entry per Scout.
- ◆ There will be ONE WINNER selected for the front cover.
- ♦ The second through fifth place winners will be displayed on the back cover of the yearbook.
- ♦ All who submit an entry will have their names appear in the yearbook.
- ◆ All entries MUST have the scout's name, unit, town. Phone number and email.
- ◆ Entries due by Sept. 2 Here is how to submit your entry:
 - →Entries can be scanned and emailed to info@powhay.com. Please use high 300 dpi resolution and save the original artwork just in case we need to rescan it.




