Leader: My son, forget not my laws; but let thine heart keep my commandments.


Group: **On my honor I will do my best to obey the Scout Law.**


Group: **Amen.**


## “Appreciation for Resources”

## Respect for Our Environment


*Bahai Prayer by Baha U Llah*

## Think First and Do After


### *A Reflection from Lord Baden-Powell*


## "God Bless America"
