## **Packs**

- Have a goal to cross over every Webelos II to Scouts BSA
- 2. Involve troop in Crossover Ceremony planning
- 3. Organize troop meeting visits
- 4. Plan a Webelos II overnighter or outdoor activity with troop
- 5. Ask for Den Chief and ASM support to get to know troop leaders
- 6. Invite troop to participate in Pack recruiting events and request troop youth to help at events



## **Troops**



- 1. Serve as a resource for planning overnight activities such as equip needs, logistics, locations
- 2. Encourage youth to serve as Den Chiefs in Pack
- 3. Organize troop youth-led activities for the Pack
- 4. Plan a Scouts BSA info session for the Pack, involve troop youth leaders to run activities
- 5. Collect Webelos II names and parent names and contact info, begin communication early
- Encourage Webelos II den leaders and parents to transition into troop leadership to provide continuity / comfort level for new families
- 7. Help to plan Crossover Ceremony and participate, gift all Webelos II with a new Scouts BSA handbook
- 8. Assign an ASM to work with Webelos II from beginning of year
