After a couple of challenging years, 2022 continued to prove that Scouting is alive and well in our communities.

In 2022, the Connecticut Yankee Council was one of 2 out of 251 Scout councils in the country to have growth in membership and growth in units year over year recruiting over 3,000 new youth into the program.
