Bronze Level

- 1. Pack has a goal to cross over every Webelos II to Scouts BSA
- 2. Pack organizes Webelos II visit to troop meeting and outdoor activity
- 3. Pack invites local troops to Crossover Ceremony
- 4. Troop serves as a resource for overnight activities equip, logistics, etc.

Silver Level

- 1. Pack plans a Webelos II overnighter with troop
- 2. Pack involves local troops in Crossover Ceremony planning SPL welcomes crossovers with a handshake and Scouts BSA Handbook
- 3. Troop provides Den Chiefs for local packs, especially for Webelos II
- 4. Troop youth run activities for local packs
- 5. Troop runs a 'Scouts BSA Night' for local packs youth run activities for cubs while adults give info session (aims/methods, youth-led, calendar)

Gold Level

- 1. Troop collects Webelos II names, parent names, contact info in Sep
- 2. Troop plans recruitment activities with packs and sends youth leaders
- 3. Troop encourages Webelos II den leaders and parents to join troop leadership to provide continuity and comfort level for new families
- 4. Troop assigns ASM to work with Webelos II at beginning of program year
- 5. All activities above are scheduled during annual planning
