To help you get started, we've assembled this packet of flyers and key dates for upcoming District and Council events — including camporees and special programs.



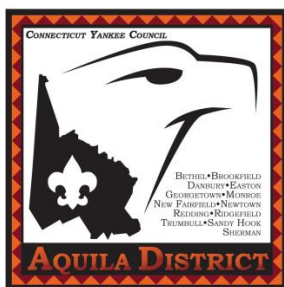

Safeguarding Youth Training (SYT) – Now Required Annually
Scouting America's new SYT replaces Youth Protection Training and is mandatory every year for all registered adult volunteers and new members.

- 90 minutes (English & Spanish)
- Access at my.scouting.org
- Score 80%+ to pass
- After year one: 15-minute refresher + retest annually

Important: Only SYT is accepted moving forward. Volunteers not current at recharter will not be re-registered.

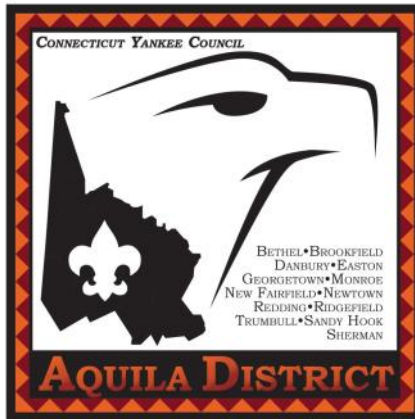

- We are also asking Packs to adopt the CYC Official Pinewood Derby Guidelines for their race.

The District Pinewood Derby Championship is an exciting event where top racers from each Packs come together to compete for the title of District Champion! It's a day filled with Scout spirit, competition, and fun — celebrating the creativity and effort each Scout puts into their car.

Who can race? The top 3 racers from each rank — Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelos, and Arrow of Light — for a total of 18 Scouts per Pack.

Each Pack is encouraged to host their own Pinewood Derby prior to this event, **using the CYC Official Pinewood Derby Guidelines** to ensure fairness and consistency.

Council-Wide Pinewood Derby Championship! Date and location to be announced

The top 3 racers from each rank — Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelos, and Arrow of Light — from each District Championship will qualify to compete in this exciting council-wide finale.

Pinewood Derby Workshop — University of Adventures Saturday, November 8, 2025

Each rank has a Pinewood Derby-related Adventure Award. We plan to offer a workshop to kick off the award, share car-building tips, and provide kits and parts.

CYC Official Pinewood Derby Guidelines

Car Requirements

- Must be built using the official BSA Pinewood Derby Kit.
- Must be constructed in the current race year by the Cub Scout racing it.

Dimensions & Weight

- Length: Max 7"
- Width: Max 2¾"
- Height: Max 3"
- Clearance: Min 1¾" between wheels and 3/8" underneath
- Wheelbase: Between 4¼" and 4 5/8"
- Weight: Max 5.00 oz (measured on official scale)

Wheels & Axles

- Must use official BSA wheels and axles.
- Wheels may be polished but not reshaped, beveled, or lathed.
- Axles may be polished and lubricated — but:
 - BENDING OF THE AXLE IS NOT ALLOWED.
 - ALL FOUR WHEELS MUST BE IN CONTACT WITH THE TRACK.
 - This ensures fairness and compliance with the official wheel-width guidelines.
 - Only dry lubricant is permitted.

Prohibited Modifications

- No bearings, washers, bushings, or springs
- No starting devices — cars must be freewheeling
- No liquids or loose weights (e.g., lead shot)

Race Procedures

- Cars must pass inspection to race.
- After check-in, only race officials may handle the cars.
- Racemaster will determine reasonable repair time allowed for cars that break during the race.
- No lubrication at the race venue.
- Racemaster's decisions are final.

Conduct

- Unsportsmanlike behavior from any Scout, leader, or spectator may result in disqualification or removal from the event.

Winter 1776: Scouts of the Revolution
Saugatuck Klondike Derby 2026
Honoring 250 Years of American Spirit

January 23–25, 2026,
Hoyt Scout Reservation

Travel back in time to the winter of 1776 and experience life as a Continental Army scout during the fight for American independence. Your patrol has been called into service under **General George Washington**, tasked with surviving the cold, completing critical missions, and supporting the cause of liberty — all while enduring the realities of a Revolutionary War winter.

This year's Klondike Derby kicks off our **Semiquincentennial Celebration — 250 years of American history**, courage, and innovation. Through a series of hands-on challenges, you'll test your strength, skills, and teamwork the way a young soldier might have — hauling gear, building fire and shelter, carrying messages, and navigating unfamiliar terrain with only the land and the stars as your guide.

Are you ready to serve your country — and your patrol — in the spirit of 1776?

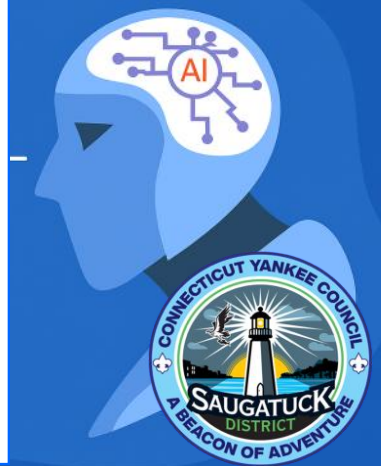
