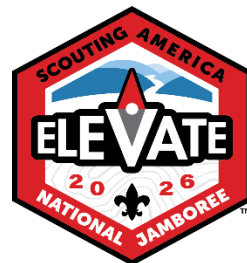


# Connecticut Yankee Council 2026 National Scout Jamboree

**Dates and Location:** The 2026 National Jamboree will be held Wednesday, July 22, through Friday, July 31, 2026, at the Summit Bechtel Family National Scout Reserve (The Summit) in Glen Jean, West Virginia. The Connecticut Yankee Council is in conjunction with Greenwich & Housatonic councils plans to take 100 Scouts for the 14-day adventure (**Sunday, July 19, 2026 to Saturday, August 1, 2026**) with amazing activities on the way down.

## What Can You Do At The Jamboree?

- A wide range of merit badges offered by the BSA.
- Ziplines, climbing, aquatics, and shooting are always popular activities at the Jamboree.
- Stadium shows, Leadership heights, Adventure activity and Camp life.
- Patch trading, patch trading, and more patch trading.
- **And that is just some of the things to do!**

## How Do You Attend The Jamboree?

- Scouts attend as part of a Troop made up of 36 (full troop) or 18 (half troop.)
- Each unit will have preparation meetings and attend a pre-Jamboree weekend.
- Our contingent will travel together, with each unit camping and eating meals together.

## What Does The Jamboree Cost?

- The cost for each youth is \$2850, including a \$450 non-refundable deposit. **Fee increases to \$3100 on Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>.** Deposit must be paid by October 31<sup>st</sup> to avoid fee increase.
- A monthly payment plan is available to spread out the cost.
- Fundraising and other money-saving options will be available to help lower the cost.
- Includes pre-trip to Hershey Park, transportation, lodging and meals.
- Each participant will be issued Jamboree T-shirts, duffle bag and daypack, as well as a neckerchief and slide.

## Can I Attend?

- As a Scout:
  - Be a currently registered member of Scouting America in a Scouts BSA troop, Venturing Crew, or Sea Scout Ship.
  - A Scout must be at least 12 years of age and no older than 17 years of age.
  - Participate in the pre-Jamboree weekend.
  - Have approval from your Scoutmaster.
- As a contingent adult leader, an adult must:
  - Be a currently registered member of Scouting America
  - No less than 21 years of age
  - \$450 deposit fee is **refundable** if not selected as a contingent leader.
